## Parent Council Events

We run various events throughout the year. Here's a basic summary although others will happen as we find the need or the motivation:

#### Discos

We run three discos throughout the year at Halloween, Spring and Summer. We bring in a DJ who does party games as well. Our role is to decorate the hall, prepare food and drink plus run a photo booth and any other activities felt appropriate. We charge for the first two discos but the Summer one is a freebie as our present to the children at the end of the school year.

#### Christmas Fayre

We organise a Christmas Fayre around the end of November to have some Festive fun and raise some funds. We sell stalls to external organisations (some even run by parents) plus each class runs a stall either with a game or selling things they've made. Plus there's always a visit from a very special guest. It's a great night but always needs a good team of helpers for the refreshments and any side shows we decide to run ourselves.

#### May Fayre

Similar to the Christmas Fayre but much warmer and outside (hopefully)! External groups are invited in and we put on various side shows too. It runs from 2-4pm so all children are guaranteed to benefit from enjoying it either with their class teacher or their grown up. This is probably out biggest event for needs helpers but it's a great fun event to be a part of.

#### Golden Café

A selection of healthy snacks sold to the infant end on Friday afternoons. See separate sheet for more information on this important offering to the younger children in the school.

#### Christmas Parties

We purchase and organise the food for these class celebrations. There's a lot happening over a short period of time so the more helpers the better. And if you volunteer for your own child's class party you get to see them enjoying time with their friends in this setting.

### **Events Team**
